## TAKE ACTION NOW

The CRSMCA Political Action Committee would like to offer a simple and easy way for the CRSMCA members (contractors and associates), and small business advocates to oppose The Miner Safety and Health Act H.R. 5663 currently being debated by Congress.

H.R. 5663 will impose substantial cost on American employers. The bill exposes employers to vague new standards of intent for criminal liability and will make “any officer or director” or mine “operator” subject to criminal penalties. This expanded liability and penalties will force employers to increase legal fees and litigation. The bill contains no provisions that would help employers improve their workplace safety program. Small business would benefit from OSHA expanding their support programs and serving as a resource to employers, as well as an enforcement agency. This legislation relies on a belief that more penalties will lead to better safety in the workplace.
